

RESOLUTION NO. A-_____

1 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department of the City of Lincoln proposes to
 2 apply for assistance from the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for Land and Water
 3 Conservation funds for the purpose of renovating four neighborhood park playgrounds
 4 (Neighbors, Easterday, Cripple Creek, and Lintel Parks); and

5 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln has available and will apply its share of the project cost
 6 (\$200,000) and has the financial capability to maintain and will maintain the completed
 7 improvements in a safe and attractive manner for public use.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,
 9 Nebraska:

10 The City of Lincoln hereby expresses its support for the application being made by its
 11 Parks and Recreation Department to the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for federal
 12 assistance from the Land and Water Conservation Grant to provide financial support for the
 13 renovation of Neighbors, Easterday, Cripple Creek, and Lintel Parks.

14 The City of Lincoln has budgeted its 50 percent match to the proposed funding total and
 15 will allocate these funds toward this project upon project approval by NGPC. The City has the
 16 financial capacity to operate and maintain the completed project and park property in a safe,
 17 attractive, and sanitary manner.

18 The City of Lincoln will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color,
 19 age, religion, disability, sex, or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or
 20 developed pursuant to the project proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of Title
 21 VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, P.L. 88-354(1964), and any of the regulations promulgated
 22 pursuant to such Act by the Secretary of the Interior and contained in 43 CFR 17.

1 No property acquired and/or developed under this project shall, without the approval of
2 NGPC and the Secretary of the Interior, be converted to other than public outdoor recreation
3 use. Such approval may be granted only if it is in accord with the then existing Statewide
4 Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan (SCORP), and only upon such conditions as deemed
5 necessary to assure the substitution of other outdoor recreation properties of at least equal fair
6 market value and of reasonably equivalent usefulness and location. The City will replace the
7 land in the event of a conversion in use in accordance with Section 6(f)(3) of the Land and
8 Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965, as amended.

9 The City agrees to comply with all State and Federal requirements and standards where
10 they can be applied in making the facilities developed under this project, and all future projects,
11 accessible to and usable by the disabled.

12 The Mayor is hereby authorized to sign all documents to obtain financial assistance,
13 including a Project Agreement with the State of Nebraska and the National Park Service.

14 The City Clerk is directed to transmit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Parks and
15 Recreation Department for inclusion with the application to the Nebraska Game and Parks
16 Commission.
