

RESOLUTION NO. A-\_\_\_\_\_

1 WHEREAS, the City of Lincoln has previously adopted Resolution No. A-85023  
2 amending the City of Lincoln Design Standards to add Chapter 3.100, Design Standards for Outdoor  
3 Lighting, providing design standards for the installation of outdoor luminaires; and

4 WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and Utilities in coordination with Lincoln  
5 Electric System has proposed to reissue Chapter 3.100 of the Design Standards for Outdoor Lighting  
6 with amendments as shown on Attachment “A” which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by  
7 reference. Said amendments amend Section 3. Definitions to revise the definition of “Lumen,  
8 Luminaire, and Mounting height”; amend subsection 4.1 of Section 4. Class I Lighting to correct the  
9 spelling of foot-candles; amend Section 6. Class III Lighting (Street Lighting) to amend subsection  
10 6.2 Design Requirements to refer to the latest addition of the cited IESNA Standard; amend  
11 subsection 6.3 Standard Street Lighting and subsection 6.4 Ornamental Street Lighting to require  
12 LED light sources for local residential streets and to further require under subsection 6.4 certain  
13 specified street light intensity; amend subsection 6.7 Arterial Street Lighting to refer to roadway  
14 luminaires instead of street lights; amend subsection 7.1.C.1 of Section 7. Class IV Lighting,  
15 subsection A.2. of Section 9. Light Trespass and Glare, and subsection D of Section 12. Permanent  
16 Exemptions to correct spelling and grammatical errors; and repeal Sections 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, and 12 of  
17 Chapter 3.100 as hitherto existing.

18 WHEREAS, the City Council desires to encourage and promote the installation of  
19 LED post top fixtures not required in a previously approved final plat by agreeing to subsidize the  
20 increased cost to subdividers to install ornamental street lights with LED post top fixtures as opposed  
21 to HPSV post top fixtures based upon the cost differential between a HPSV Colonial/Contemporary  
22 HPSV post top fixture and comparable LED post top fixture.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln,  
2 Nebraska:

3 That Chapter 3.100, Design Standards for Outdoor Lighting, of the City of Lincoln  
4 Design Standards, adopted by the City Council on September 15, 2008 by Resolution No. A-85023,  
5 be and the same is hereby amended and restated in its entirety as shown on Attachment "A" which  
6 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these amendments to Chapter 3.100 of the  
8 Design Standards for Outdoor Lighting shall only apply to final plats that are filed on or after the  
9 date of this Resolution, except that in order to promote the installation of ornamental street lighting  
10 with LED post top fixtures in any final plat filed on or before the date of this Resolution, the City  
11 may require the installation of a LED post top fixture by agreeing to pay one hundred percent (100%)  
12 of the cost differential between the cost of the approved HPSV post top fixture and the cost of a  
13 comparable LED post top fixture.
