

ORDINANCE NO. _____

1 AN ORDINANCE amending Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code relating to
 2 Alcoholic Liquor Prohibited; Exceptions and Permit Requirements to include Tower Square, Auld
 3 Pavilion, and Jayne Snyder Trails Center in subsections (c) and (d); and repealing Section 12.08.270 of
 4 the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing.

5 BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lincoln, Nebraska:

6 Section 1. That Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code be amended to read as
 7 follows:

8 **12.08.270 Alcoholic Liquor Prohibited; Exceptions and Permit Requirements.**

9 It shall be unlawful for any person to consume or to possess any alcoholic liquor in any park or
 10 park facility; provided, however, the above prohibition shall not apply to the following as they may be
 11 properly licensed or permitted according to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

12 (a) The retail licensed premises consisting of the clubhouse area of golf courses and outdoor
 13 areas of any 18-hole golf course;

14 (b) The premises of the Lincoln Children's Zoo and the Lincoln Children's Museum in
 15 conjunction with fundraising activities occurring when the zoo or museum is not otherwise open to the
 16 public;

17 (c) The premises of Hazel Abel Park, Stransky Park, Sunken Gardens, Antelope Park Rose
 18 Garden, Woods Park Tennis Center, Jayne Snyder Trails Center, Tower Square, Auld Pavilion, Pinewood
 19 Bowl, and Pioneers Park Nature Center, in conjunction with fundraising activities sponsored only by and
 20 for the Parks and Recreation Department or by non-profit organizations specifically organized to benefit
 21 any city department when the premises or the area of the activity is not otherwise open to the public; and

22 (d) The premises of Pinewood Bowl, in conjunction with events sponsored by the ~~for~~ Parks
 23 and Recreation Department ~~sponsored events.~~ and programmed or operated by the Arena operator
 24 pursuant to any contracts in effect; and

1 (e) The premises of Tower Square, in conjunction with events promoting downtown
2 economic development sponsored by the Downtown Lincoln Association in consultation with the Parks
3 and Recreation Department; and

4 (f) The premises of the Jayne Snyder Trail Center specifically by a condominium unit owner
5 in the Active Living Center Condominium Association and pursuant to written agreement.

6 (g) The Director shall develop rules and regulations regarding alcoholic liquor in some or all
7 parks and parks facilities.

8 Section 2. That Section 12.08.270 of the Lincoln Municipal Code as hitherto existing be
9 and the same is hereby repealed.

10 Section 3. Pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall be
11 posted on the official bulletin board of the City, located on the wall across from the City Clerk's office at
12 555 S. 10th Street, in lieu of and in place of newspaper publication with notice of passage and such
13 posting to be given by publication one time in the official newspaper by the City Clerk. This ordinance
14 shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as herein and in the City
15 Charter provided.
