The Public Works & Utilities Department has received the attached request for use of the Right-of-Way to construct seating walls, columns, arches, lighting features and monument wall adjacent to the properties at 3800 South 48th Street and 4801 Prescott Avenue. Union College proposes to construct an entryway into the Union College Campus on the east side of the intersection of South 48th Street and Prescott Avenue. The improvements will extend into the Public Right-of-Way. The proposed area of right-of-way occupied by the walls and improvements is estimated at 350 square feet.
