I saw my first bullet wound when I was seven years old. My father was shot in an accidental shooting at a Lincoln bar where he had gone after work to have a beer with his co-workers. The accident was caused by a stranger, an intoxicated bar patron, showing off his loaded gun to friends. Though his injury was not life threatening, it was the first time in my life that I realized my father, a hard-working Vietnam veteran, could be taken from our family due the carelessness of a stranger.

This summer, outside of the Lincoln Children's Zoo, children found a gun in a backpack near the bike trail, carelessly left unattended by a construction worker working nearby. My seven year old was at a zoo camp that day. I do not feel safe knowing that construction workers feel they need to arm themselves at job sites, yet are not responsible enough to keep track of their guns.

The newspaper crime blotters regularly list guns being taken from vehicles. It should not be so easy to steal a gun. A safe storage ordinance would hopefully make gun owners rethink leaving their guns unattended and accessible to thieves and kids.

This isn't the wild west. We should not have to live in fear of our families being killed or injured due to gun violence.

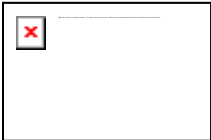
