



## LLCHD FARMERS MARKET GUIDELINES

1. E-mailing customer lists and posting guidelines at entrances with rules which are standard for all stores and including additional provisions specific to Farmers Markets.
2. Encourage and enforce social distancing. That means having staff circulating to educate customers to maintain proper distances.
3. Distancing tables. This is the practical challenge that markets will need to solve. It may mean relocating or expanding spaces so there is at least 10 feet between vendor booths.
4. Vendors should round prices to the nearest dollar to discourage use and exchange of coins.
5. Customers will be asked not to touch produce, but just point at what they need and let vendors bag purchases.
6. Seating will not be provided to discourage gathering, lingering, and consumption of food and drink at the market.
7. Vendors will not be allowed to provide samples of products.
8. Vendors will not use porous tablecloths to make it easier to sanitize surfaces.
9. Encourage vendors to wear disposable gloves.
10. Vendors, as much as possible, will have one person to handle money and another person to handle produce.
11. Encourage each vendor to have a hand washing station or to provide sanitizer.
12. Food will be limited to whole produce and packaged food items.

13. Both customers and vendors should have access to a restroom with proper hand washing facilities.
14. High touch areas such as debit card machines and tabletops must be disinfected often.
15. Music, community, and kids' activities are not allowed.
