CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered by and between **K2 Construction, 7701 Cornhusker Highway, Lincoln, NE 68462**, hereinafter called "Contractor", and the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called "City".

WHEREAS, the City has caused to be prepared, in accordance with law, Specifications, Plans, and other Contract Documents for the Work herein described, and has approved and adopted said documents and has caused to be published an advertisement for and in connection with said Work, to-wit:

For providing Annual Requirements for Snow Removal - Truck Mounted Snow Plow Services, Bid No. 14-143 and,

WHEREAS, the Contractor, in response to such advertisement, has submitted to the City, in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed Proposal/Supplier Response in accordance with the terms of said advertisement; and,

WHEREAS, the City, in the manner prescribed by law has publicly opened, read aloud, examined, and canvassed the Proposals/Supplier Responses submitted in response to such advertisement, and as a result of such canvass has determined and declared the Contractor to be the lowest responsible bidder for the said Work for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's Proposal/Supplier Responses, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sums to be paid to the Contractor and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Contractor and the City has agreed and hereby agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to (a) furnish all tools, equipment, supplies, superintendence, transportation, and other accessories, services, and facilities; (b) furnish all materials, supplies, and equipment specified to be incorporated into and form a permanent part of the complete work; (c) provide and perform all necessary labor in a substantial and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents; and (d) execute and complete all Work included in and covered by the City's award of this Contract to the Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance by the City of the Contractor's Proposal, or part thereof, as follows:

Agreement to full proposal (2) plow trucks.

2. The City agrees to pay to the Contractor for the performance of the Work embraced in this Contract, the Contractor agrees to accept as full compensation therefore, the following sums and prices for all Work covered by and included in the Contract award and designated above, payment thereof to be made in the manner provided by the City:

The Owners will pay for products/services, according to the Line Item pricing as listed in Contractors Proposal/Supplier Response, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract. All contracts awarded from Bid No. 14-143 will combine for a total amount estimated at \$34,400.00.

3. **Equal Employment Opportunity.** In connection with the carrying out of this project, the contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

4. E-Verify. In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 4-108 through 4-114, the contractor agrees to register with and use a federal immigration verification system, to determine the work eligibility status of new employees performing services within the state of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324 a, otherwise known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this section pursuant to the requirements of state law and 8 U.S.C.A 1324b. The contractor shall require any subcontractor to comply with the provisions of this section.
5. Termination. This Contract may be terminated by the following:
 - 5.1) Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this Contract upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party for any reason without penalty.
 - 5.2) Termination for Cause. The City may terminate the Contract for cause if the Contractor:
 - 5.2.1) Refuses or fails to supply the proper labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide services and/or commodities.
 - 5.2.2) Disregards Federal, State or local laws, ordinances, regulations, resolutions or orders.
 - 5.2.3) Otherwise commits a substantial breach or default of any provision of the Contract Document. In the event of a substantial breach or default the City will provide the Contractor written notice of said breach or default and allow the Contractor ten (10) days from the date of the written notice to cure such breach or default. If said breach or default is not cured within ten (10) days from the date of notice, then the contract shall terminate.
6. Independent Contractor. It is the express intent of the parties that this contract shall not create an employer-employee relationship. Employees of the Contractor shall not be deemed to be employees of the City and employees of the City shall not be deemed to be employees of the Contractor. The Contractor and the City shall be responsible to their respective employees for all salary and benefits. Neither the Contractor's employees nor the City's employees shall be entitled to any salary, wages, or benefits from the other party, including but not limited to overtime, vacation, retirement benefits, workers' compensation, sick leave or injury leave. Contractor shall also be responsible for maintaining workers' compensation insurance, unemployment insurance for its employees, and for payment of all federal, state, local and any other payroll taxes with respect to its employees' compensation.
7. Contract Term. This Contract shall be effective upon execution by both parties. The term of the Contract shall be a (1) one year term with the option to renew for up to three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
8. The Contract Documents comprise the Contract, and consist of the following:
 1. Contract Agreement
 2. Accepted Proposal/Supplier Response
 3. Specifications
 4. Special Provisions
 5. Insurance Requirements
 6. Instructions to Bidders
 7. Notice to Bidders
 8. Sales Tax Exemption Form 13

These Contract Agreements, together with the other Contract Documents herein above mentioned, form this Contract, and they are as fully a part of the Contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

The Contractor and the City hereby agree that all the terms and conditions of this Contract shall be binding upon themselves, and their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Contractor and the City do hereby execute this contract.

**SPECIFICATION
SNOW REMOVAL - TRUCK MOUNTED SNOWPLOW SERVICES**

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 The City of Lincoln is requesting bids from Contractors to assist in snow removal from City streets using Truck Mounted Snowplow.
- 1.2 Contractor shall furnish truck(s) with Snowplow and operator(s) for the purpose of plowing snow for the City of Lincoln during the winter season beginning on or about November 15 and ending on or about May 1.
 - 1.2.1 Services may be required outside of these dates and Contractor agrees to provide services as needed.
- 1.3 The City intends to enter into a contract for a one (1) year term with the option to renew for up to three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
 - 1.3.1 If the Contractor agrees to renewal, number and type of trucks will be verified each year at time of renewal.
 - 1.3.2 Pricing must remain firm during the initial contract term.
- 1.4 Bidder shall submit bid documents and all supporting material via e-bid.
 - 1.4.1 Contractor may bid as many trucks that meet the requirements of this specification; however, a new Line Item must be completed for each truck proposed.
- 1.5 All inquiries regarding these specifications shall be directed via e-mail or faxed written request to Sharon Mulder, Asst. Purchasing Agent (smulder@lincoln.ne.gov) or fax: (402) 441-6513.
 - 1.5.1 These inquiries and/or responses shall be distributed to prospective bidders electronically as an addenda
 - 1.5.2 The Purchasing Office shall only reply to written inquiries received within five (5) calendar days of bid opening.
 - 1.5.3 No direct contact is allowed between Vendor and other City staff throughout the bid process.
 - 1.5.3.1 Failure to comply with this directive may result in Vendor bid being rejected.
- 1.6 A pre-bid meeting will be held on Friday, May 30th at 1:30 p.m. located at the Municipal Service Training Room.
 - 1.6.1 The address is 901 W. Bond Street, Lincoln, NE 68521
 - 1.6.2 Enter in on the NW Entrance near cafeteria.
- 1.7 Annual Training is a mandatory requirement for all Truck Mounted Snowplow Service operators.
 - 1.7.1 Operators who fail to attend training class will not be allowed to plow snow until their training is made up.
 - 1.7.1.1 Training shall be monitored by the City.
 - 1.7.2 All awarded contractors shall be notified the details of the training class(es) by the City of Lincoln, Street and Maintenance Department.

2. CONTRACT AND CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

- 2.1 Within fourteen (14) calendar days after the award of the bid, the Contractor shall sign and return the contract to the City of Lincoln.
- 2.2 Also within such time period, the Contractor must furnish a Certificate of Insurance in accordance with the requirements specified in the bid documents.
 - 2.2.1 All Certificates of Insurance shall be filed with the City of Lincoln on the standard Accord Certificate of Insurance form showing the specific limits of insurance coverage required, and showing the **City of Lincoln as an "additional insured"** as pertains to snow removal services.
 - 2.2.2 Such Certification shall specifically state that insurance policies are to be endorsed to require the insurer to provide the City of Lincoln thirty days notice of cancellation or non-renewal of any material reduction of insurance coverage.

3. MINIMUM TRUCK SPECIFICATION

- 3.1 The Contractor shall furnish truck-mounted reversible snow plows for such purpose that meet or exceed the following specifications:
 - 3.1.1 (Truck Power Unit)
 - 3.1.1.1 ENGINE: Gasoline or Diesel powered, 350 cubic inch minimum displacement.
 - 3.1.1.2 HORSEPOWER: 150 minimum net.
 - 3.1.1.3 GVWR: 27,500 lbs. minimum.
 - 3.1.1.4 FRONT AXLE: 10,000 lbs. minimum.
 - 3.1.1.5 CAB TO AXLE: 84 inches minimum.
 - 3.1.1.6 FUEL TANK: Not less than 50 U.S. gallons.
 - 3.1.1.7 Truck must be of dump design, capable of transporting sufficient ballast during plowing operations to provide for proper traction and stability without exceeding GVW ratings.
 - 3.1.1.8 LIGHTS: All lights required by FMVSS 108 plus a revolving or strobe type beacon.
 - 3.1.1.9 POWER POINT: Shall have one or be willing to let the City install one.
 - 3.1.2 (SNOWPLOW AND HITCH)
 - 3.1.2.1 10 ft. hydraulically reversible snowplow with attaching hitch.
 - 3.1.2.2 LENGTH: 10 ft. straight blade minimum @ 0°.
 - 3.1.3 PATH CLEARING
 - 3.1.3.1 9' 10" @ 10°.
 - 3.1.3.2 9' 5" @ 20°.
 - 3.1.3.3 8' 8" @ 30°.
 - 3.1.3.4 8' 0" @ 37°.
 - 3.1.4 HEIGHT: 39 inches minimum.
 - 3.1.5 10 USS gauge minimum.
 - 3.1.6 Approximate weight of moldboard 1700 lbs.
(Note: Please state weight of moldboard in the item attribute provided.)
 - 3.1.7 Minimum lift height from ground 14 inches.
(Note: Please state lift height from ground in the item the attribute provided.)
 - 3.1.8 BLADE: High carbon steel 5/8" x 8" x 10'.
 - 3.1.9 HITCH: Must be of sufficient construction and strength to safely carry, lift and push the snowplow.
 - 3.1.10 The City reserves the right to inspect all snowplow units bid to insure that they are of sufficient design and construction to safely and efficiently remove snow from City streets.

4. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- 4.1 Contractor shall be responsible for all fuel, lubricants, repair and maintenance of the truck, plow and hitch.
- 4.2 The Contractor is an independent Contractor, and neither the Contractor nor his/her employees or agents shall be considered for any purpose to be employees of the City.
 - 4.2.1 Contractor shall be responsible to provide qualified operator(s) for the truck plows.
 - 4.2.2 Any such operator shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age, shall hold a valid Nebraska commercial motor vehicle operator's license, and shall be skilled in operation of the Contractor's equipment for snow-plowing purposes.
- 4.3 Contractor shall respond for the purpose of plowing snow from City streets in accordance with the City of Lincoln Ice and Snow Control Plan within a maximum of two (2) hours after being called by the City Director of Public Works or his/her designated representative.
 - 4.3.1 The City will make every attempt to give a 1-1/2 hour notice.
- 4.4 Contractor shall notify the City of Lincoln of any mechanical failure to the truck plow that prevents its use for snow-plowing.
 - 4.4.1 As soon as the mechanical failure is repaired, Contractor shall notify the City of

- Lincoln that the unit is again available.
- 4.4.2 No hourly rate of payment shall be made to the Contractor for his/her maintenance and repair during this "downtime" and the hourly rate will not resume until the equipment is back in use in the field.

5. **CITY RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 5.1 The City will provide to the Contractor assigned district(s) for snow plowing, including maps showing the district boundaries and the streets within the districts.
- 5.1.1 More than one Contractor may be assigned to districts and they will be expected to work together as a team.
- 5.2 Upon completion of snow removal within contractors assigned district, contractor shall report to the assigned district shop for reassignment or release by the district supervisor.
- 5.3 If snow plowing is required for an extended period of time, Contractor must make shift changes at a location in the same area that plowing is being conducted.
- 5.4 The City has the option of installing a temporary GPS Tracking System in the truck to track the progress of snow removal.
- 5.4.1 The City will be responsible for the installation and removal of Tracking System.
