**CITY OF LINCOLN
CONTRACT AGREEMENT**

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this _____ day of _____ 2012, by and between **B & B Greenhouses, 4200 South 1st Street, Lincoln, NE 68502**, hereinafter called "Contractor", and the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, hereinafter called "City".

WHEREAS, the City has caused to be prepared, in accordance with law, Specifications, Plans, and other Contract Documents for the Work herein described, and has approved and adopted said documents and has caused to be published an advertisement for and in connection with said Work, to-wit:

For providing **Annual Supply of Bedding Plants, Bid No. 12-292** and,

WHEREAS, the Contractor, in response to such advertisement, has submitted to the City, in the manner and at the time specified, a sealed Proposal/Supplier Response in accordance with the terms of said advertisement; and,

WHEREAS, the City, in the manner prescribed by law has publicly opened, read aloud, examined, and canvassed the Proposals/Supplier Responses submitted in response to such advertisement, and as a result of such canvass has determined and declared the Contractor to be the lowest responsible bidder for the said Work for the sum or sums named in the Contractor's Proposal/Supplier Responses, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sums to be paid to the Contractor and the mutual covenants herein contained, the Contractor and the City has agreed and hereby agree as follows:

1. The Contractor agrees to (a) furnish all tools, equipment, supplies, superintendence, transportation, and other accessories, services, and facilities; (b) furnish all materials, supplies, and equipment specified to be incorporated into and form a permanent part of the complete work; (c) provide and perform all necessary labor in a substantial and workmanlike manner and in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents; and (d) execute and complete all Work included in and covered by the City's award of this Contract to the Contractor, such award being based on the acceptance by the City of the Contractor's Proposal, or part thereof, as follows:

Agreement to full proposal

2. The City agrees to pay to the Contractor for the performance of the Work embraced in this Contract, the Contractor agrees to accept as full compensation therefore, the following sums and prices for all Work covered by and included in the Contract award and designated above, payment thereof to be made in the manner provided by the City:

City will pay for products/service, according to the Line Item pricing as listed in Contractors Proposal/Supplier Response, a copy thereof being attached to and made a part of this Contract. The City shall order on an as needed basis for the duration of the contract.

3. Equal Employment Opportunity. In connection with the carrying out of this project, the contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

4. E-Verify. In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 4-108 through 4-114, the contractor agrees to register with and use a federal immigration verification system, to determine the work eligibility status of new employees performing services within the state of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324 a, otherwise known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this section pursuant to the requirements of state law and 8 U.S.C.A 1324b. The contractor shall require any subcontractor to comply with the provisions of this section.
5. Termination. This Contract may be terminated by the following:
 - 5.1) Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this Contract upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party for any reason without penalty.
 - 5.2) Termination for Cause. The City may terminate the Contract for cause if the Contractor:
 - 5.2.1) Refuses or fails to supply the proper labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide services and/or commodities.
 - 5.2.2) Disregards Federal, State or local laws, ordinances, regulations, resolutions or orders.
 - 5.2.3) Otherwise commits a substantial breach or default of any provision of the Contract Document. In the event of a substantial breach or default the City will provide the Contractor written notice of said breach or default and allow the Contractor ten (10) days from the date of the written notice to cure such breach or default. If said breach or default is not cured within ten (10) days from the date of notice, then the contract shall terminate.
6. Independent Contractor. It is the express intent of the parties that this contract shall not create an employer-employee relationship. Employees of the Contractor shall not be deemed to be employees of the City and employees of the City shall not be deemed to be employees of the Contractor. The Contractor and the City shall be responsible to their respective employees for all salary and benefits. Neither the Contractor's employees nor the City's employees shall be entitled to any salary, wages, or benefits from the other party, including but not limited to overtime, vacation, retirement benefits, workers' compensation, sick leave or injury leave. Contractor shall also be responsible for maintaining workers' compensation insurance, unemployment insurance for its employees, and for payment of all federal, state, local and any other payroll taxes with respect to its employees' compensation.
7. Contract Term. This Contract shall be effective upon execution by both parties. The term of the Contract shall be a one (1) year term, with option to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year terms.
8. The Contract Documents comprise the Contract, and consist of the following:

 3. Addendums No. 1
 4. Special Provisions
 5. Specifications
 6. 2013 Display Gardens: Lincoln Parks and Rec. Dept. - Order Sheet

These Contract Agreements, together with the other Contract Documents herein above mentioned, form this Contract, and they are as fully a part of the Contract as if hereto attached or herein repeated.

The Contractor and the City hereby agree that all the terms and conditions of this Contract shall be binding upon themselves, and their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

**SPECIFICATIONS
FOR
GROWING AND SUPPLYING
BEDDING PLANTS**

1. SCOPE OF PROJECT

- 1.1 The Contractor shall furnish and deliver to the City, specified types, sizes and quantities of bedding plants, including annuals, perennials, ornamental grasses as ordered by the Park Horticulturist, or designated representative, during the term of the agreement.
- 1.1.1 The Contractor shall also store, grow and deliver certain plants provided by the City at the end of each growing season.
- 1.1.2 The estimated annual requirements of bedding plants are as follows:

SECTION 1. [Annual Bedding Plants, at Unit Prices]:

- Category I Annual Bedding Plants (Seed Source), 2½" pots.....12,850 plants.
Examples: Impatiens, Ageratum.
- Category II Annual Bedding Plants (cutting source), 2½" pots.....12,850 plants.
Examples: Alternanthera , Albuliton.
- Category III Annual Bedding Plants (Patented)
Examples: Coleus
- Category IV Annual Bedding Plants (Bulbs)
Examples: Canna Rhizomes

SECTION 2. [Storing and growing Rhizomatous Plants]

- Category III Rhizomatous storage, 4" pots.....per square foot.
Examples: Canna's, Purple Fountain Grass, Elephant Ear Caladium.
- Category IV Rhizomatous storage,per square foot.
Example: Banana's.

SECTION 3. [Perennial Bedding Plants at Discount Percent off of List Prices]

- Category V Perennial Plants, [fibrous root] - 2½" to 1gal pots.....450 plants.

- 1.2 Bid prices are to include cost of the bedding plant materials, storage of soft plant materials and delivery to the numerous locations in the City of Lincoln.

- 1.3 Term of agreement is one (1) year, beginning November 1, 2012 or upon execution with options to renew for three (3) additional one-year terms.
- 1.4 Bidder shall submit bid documents and all supporting material via e-bid.
- 1.5 All inquiries regarding these specifications shall be directed via e-mail or faxed request to Sharon Mulder, Asst. Purchasing Agent (smulder@lincoln.ne.gov) Or Fax: (402) 441-6513.
 - 1.5.1 These inquiries and/or responses shall be distributed as needed to prospective bidders electronically as an addenda.
 - 1.5.2 The Purchasing Office shall only reply to written inquiries received within five (5) calendar days of bid opening.
 - 1.5.3 No direct contact is allowed between Vendor and City staff throughout the bid process.
 - 1.5.3.1 Failure to comply with this directive may result in Vendor bid being rejected.

2. CONTRACTOR QUALIFICATIONS

- 2.1 Contractor must be licensed according to the Nebraska Plant Protection and Plant Pest Act & Associated Regulations.

3. MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

- 3.1 The City shall provide a listing of Annual Bedding and Storage plant species and approximate quantities by October 31, of the contract year.
 - 3.1.1 The vendor will have 45 days to determine and verify seed and supplies and respond in writing to the City regarding any anticipated difficulties in securing seed or supplies.
- 3.2 Plant material shall be heated greenhouse grown in sterilized soil with all necessary and correct nutrients added to assure desired quality with water suitable for growing plants available.
- 3.3 Uniform plant height throughout a plant species is desired.
- 3.4 All plant material shall be true to name and type, and shall contain legible labels assuring all flats or other containers are identified.
 - 3.4.1 Vendors will be reviewed for compliance in keeping plant materials correctly labeled.
 - 3.4.2 Failure to meet this requirement may result in termination of agreement.
- 3.5 Labels shall clearly indicate the common name and variety.
 - 3.5.1 Each flat shall contain at least two labels.
- 3.6 Plant material shall be sound, healthy specimens and shall be first-class representatives of their species or variety.
- 3.7 Plants shall have stocky, well-formed tops and healthy well-developed root systems.
- 3.8 Non-blooming plants are preferred.
- 3.9 Plants shall receive routine fertilization as is customary for each unique species.
- 3.10 Plant material which lack proper proportions, have poorly developed root systems, show evidence of insect pests or disease problems or are found to not fully comply with these specifications will be subject to rejection at the City's discretion at any time.
- 3.11 Inabilities on the part of the grower to supply any portion of the agreed upon plant material shall be made known by an e-mail to the Park Horticulturist no later than March 1 of each contract year.
 - 3.11.1 The grower shall be responsible to attempt to locate replacements for failed materials prior to the City accepting any substitute varieties.
 - 3.11.2 Substitute varieties will be billed at the same price of item replaced, unless the substitute cost is normally less.
 - 3.11.2.1 The lower of the two shall govern.

3.11.3 Plant material shall not be substituted without receiving written approval from the Park Horticulturist.

4. **STORAGE, PLANTING AND GROWING RHIZOMATOUS PLANT MATERIAL**

- 4.1 Rhizomatous plant material shall be provided to the vendor by the City after the fall harvest in October of each contract year.
 - 4.1.1 Plant material numbers may vary according to fall harvest.
- 4.2 The contractor shall be responsible for growing soft plant material by maintaining proper growing conditions at the proper temperatures and with sufficient moisture to keep the plants alive and healthy.
- 4.3 Plant material must be stored in an area which is free of pests including fungus, insects and rodents.
- 4.4 The vendor may contact the Parks Horticulturist for further information regarding the culture of specific species.
- 4.5 Plant material shall be grown and delivered in the appropriate container as specified on the itemized sheet.
- 4.6 The plastic pots for growing these plants will provided by the Contractor.

5. **SITE INSPECTIONS**

- 5.1 All plant material is subject to visual inspection by the Park Horticulturist in February, March, April and two weeks prior to delivery.
- 5.2 All plant material shall be assembled at one location as a group to facilitate inspections.
- 5.3 Inspections will be made during normal working hours as arranged.
 - 5.3.1 Factors that will be observed during inspections are as follows:
 - 5.3.2 Plant quality and growing conditions.
 - 5.3.3 Health of plant material.
 - 5.3.4 Compliance with the specifications .
- 5.4 Travel and travel arrangements shall be covered by awarded vendor.
 - 5.4.1 Arrangements shall be made from the Lincoln, NE airport, unless air travel can not be arranged through Lincoln, NE; then use Eppley Airfield out of Omaha, NE.

6. **CONTAINERS**

- 6.1 Plant material shall be grown and delivered in the container as specified in the itemized list provided by the Parks Horticulturist as specified in section 3.1 of the bid.
 - 6.1.1 This list will be provided to the successful vendor upon award.
- 6.2 Flats, if utilized shall be standard plastic containers with a 36 cell count per flat.
- 6.3 Plant material specified as pot grown shall be grown and delivered in clean, sterile, plastic pots.
- 6.4 All reusable plastic materials will be returned to the grower upon request, except those retained for storing and growing rhizomatous plants.

7. **DELIVERY**

- 7.1 All plants shall be ready for delivery to start no later than April 23rd, of the current contract year.
- 7.2 Plant material shall be delivered to the City, as work schedules permit during normal working hours, or as arranged.
- 7.3 Plant material shall be delivered during such time periods when weather conditions will not produce undue stress or injury.

8. **BIDDING PROCEDURE AND CONTRACT PRICING**

- 8.1 Bidders shall complete the electronic Bidding Schedule, which will be used for the evaluation of bids.
- 8.2 Unit prices in response to categories I-IV, of this solicitation will be firm for the full term of the annual contract agreement.

- 8.2.1 It is understood that the prices will include consideration for delivery of plant material to planting locations.

- 8.3 For categories V-VIII, bidders shall attach with their bid a catalog listing perennial plant material available for the year 2013 planting season and associated retail price list.
 - 8.3.1 Attributes listing discount percentages off of the retail price list is listed for each category and must be completed in order to submit the bid.
 - 8.3.1 **NOTE:** It is understood that contract pricing shall include catalog price of the perennial plants net of discount.
- 8.4 Contractor shall submit a revised catalog of perennial plant material on or about January 1, preceding each renewal date for approval by the City of Lincoln.
 - 8.4.1 Prices indicated in the revised catalog shall remain firm for the renewal period.
- 8.5 Order sheet changes every year.

9. **AWARD**

 - 9.1.1 Accessibility to on-site inspections by the City;
 - 9.1.2 Grower's ability to meet quality standards established by the City;
 - 9.1.3 Grower's ability to produce quantities specified; and
 - 9.1.4 Past experience with at least three references.
- 9.2 Bidders must submit, as part of their proposal, a list of actual growing location(s) if other than their on-site property.
