

## **ADDENDUM #1 TO SPEC. 07-010**

Addendum #1 to Spec. 07-010 for MOPAC WEST/HUSKER LINK TRAIL to be opened on Wednesday, January 17, 2007 at 12:00 noon.

**Please note the following:**

**Question 1:** Line Item 29 “Parking Space Finish” the only parking space we see is in Trail segment 8, but Note on plan says that Trail segment 8 is not a part of this contract. If this is the Parking space what are the particulars as there is no detail or spec’s on this?

Answer: Parking Space Finish is defined in Section 2.07 of Chapter 2-Earthwork, of the City of Lincoln Standard Specifications. Contractors shall also refer to the General Landscape Notes on Sheet 16 of the plans. Note 13 of the General Notes reads: “All areas within the limits of construction shall be cleared and grubbed and have a parking space finish.”

**Question 2:** Line Item 30: “Irrigation System Repair” There is no details on the plan. How are we to determine where the repair is to take place? We could have our irrigation sub walk the trail and physically inspect the irrigation, but run the risk of not finding it all.

Answer: There are underground sprinklers adjacent to the existing sidewalk that is along side University of Nebraska property along 22<sup>nd</sup> Street from Vine to ‘W’ Street and along ‘W’ Street from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> Street. The removal of the existing sidewalk and building of the trail will require these sprinkler heads to be relocated to the edge of the new trail. All material and work associated with this task shall be done in accordance with Chapter 33-Irrigation Work, of the City of Lincoln Standard Specifications.

The pay item for “Irrigation System Repair” shall be full compensation for all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidental necessary to complete this item.

**Question 3:** Clarify “Construction Staking” It appears that the city will provide vertical and horizontal control points and our survey sub is responsible for elevations and layout.

Answer: The City will provide all of the construction staking necessary for the vertical and horizontal layout of the trail along with the elevations and layout as needed.

**Question 4:** What type of contract is this? Lump Sum Contract with unit pricing as reference or is it Unit Price Contract only?

Answer: The contract is a Unit Price Contract.

All other terms and conditions to remain unchanged.
