CITY OF LINCOLN, NEBRASKA (2007)
4th STREET ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS
“A” STREET TO “J” STREET
PROJECT NO. 540614

1. Refer to the Contract Documents, Special Provision, Environmental Clearance

Note: The City of Lincoln has received environmental clearance from HUD to proceed with the construction of the project.

2. “Refer to Plan Sheets 2 and 3, Typical Cross Sections

The horizontal limits of the 4” foundation course that is shown beneath the new pavement on the typical cross sections for 4th Street should be revised to extend to 3’-0” behind the back of the proposed curb (the horizontal limits of the foundation course should match the limits of the subgrade preparation shown on the typical cross sections). This will provide a stable platform for paving operations.

This modification does not affect the pay quantities shown on the plans or in the bid proposal. Refer to the contract provision for the Aggregate Foundation Course on page 11 of the Special Provisions. This contract provision states: “Foundation course paid for by the square yard shall not be measured directly. The overlying pavement is measured, and the pavement quantity is used as the aggregate foundation course quantity.” The quantity for the 4” Foundation Course that is shown in the bid proposal is based upon the area of the new roadway pavement shown on the plans.

3. Refer to Plan Sheet 50, Drainage Plan E

The station shown for new Storm Sewer Manhole E1 shall be revised from Sta. 128+88.49 to Station 129+88.49. The offset to the manhole and the type of manhole does not change from that shown on the plans. The pipe flowlines at Manhole E1 shall be as follows:

18” F.L. = 1144.78
43” x 63” F.L. = 1142.70 (field verify)
Exist. 48” Arch. = 1142.80 (field verify)

Response to questions received

1. Since the City is paying for the Compost, does there still need to be a bid item in the proposal?

Refer to the special provision for “Yard Waste Compost”. This provision states that the bid item for Yard Waste Compost shall include all costs associated with hauling the material to the site, placing/spreading the compost and tilling or discing required to incorporate the material into the upper 12 inches of the existing soils.

Each Bidder must acknowledge receipt of all addenda in the space provided on the Proposal Form.
