1. CLARIFICATIONS

The following are questions submitted to the Purchasing Agent along with answers:

Question 1:

Is removal of contaminated soil and treatment of contaminated groundwater considered subsidiary to the Intermediate Foundation Improvement bid item?

Answer to Question 1:

For Intermediate Foundation Improvement options, other than the "Core-out" option, if contaminated material is discovered and if directed by the Contract Administrator, the material shall be removed and hauled to the City of Lincoln landfill. Hauling the contaminated material will be paid as Extra Work. For the core-out option, hauling contaminated material is subsidiary to the pay item Intermediate Foundation Improvements.

Question 2:

Does the General Contractor need to have pollution insurance?

Answer to Question 2:

No. Hazardous Waste Liability Insurance is not required by the City of Lincoln or the Nebraska Department of Roads. However, the contractor shall obtain all applicable insurance coverage as deemed necessary by their insurance providers to perform all the construction operations on the project. Cost of Hazardous Waste Liability Insurance shall not be paid for directly but shall be subsidiary to items in which direct payment is made. The contractor shall comply with all federal, state, and local requirements for conducting work and handling contaminated materials.
