

**SECTION 24. SULFUR COMPOUND EMISSIONS – EXISTING SOURCES – EMISSION STANDARDS.**

- (A) No person shall allow sulfur oxides to be emitted from any existing fossil fuel burning equipment in excess of two and one half (2.5) pounds per million British thermal units (lbs/MMBtu) heat input, maximum two (2) hour average.
- (B) For the purpose of this section, the heat input shall be the aggregate heat content of all fuels whose products of combustion pass through a stack, or the equipment manufacturer's or designer's guaranteed maximum input, whichever is greater.
