

The wall surfaces in this building are painted to give them color and durability. Paints consists of a *pigment* which gives color, a *binder* that creates the film that the pigment is suspended in, and a *carrier* that keeps the first two components in liquid form so paint can be applied to a surface. In most paints oil or latex are used as binders, which release odors into the air throughout their lifetimes. Paints used in this library make use of a new type of solvent-free latex that significantly reduces paint toxicity.


