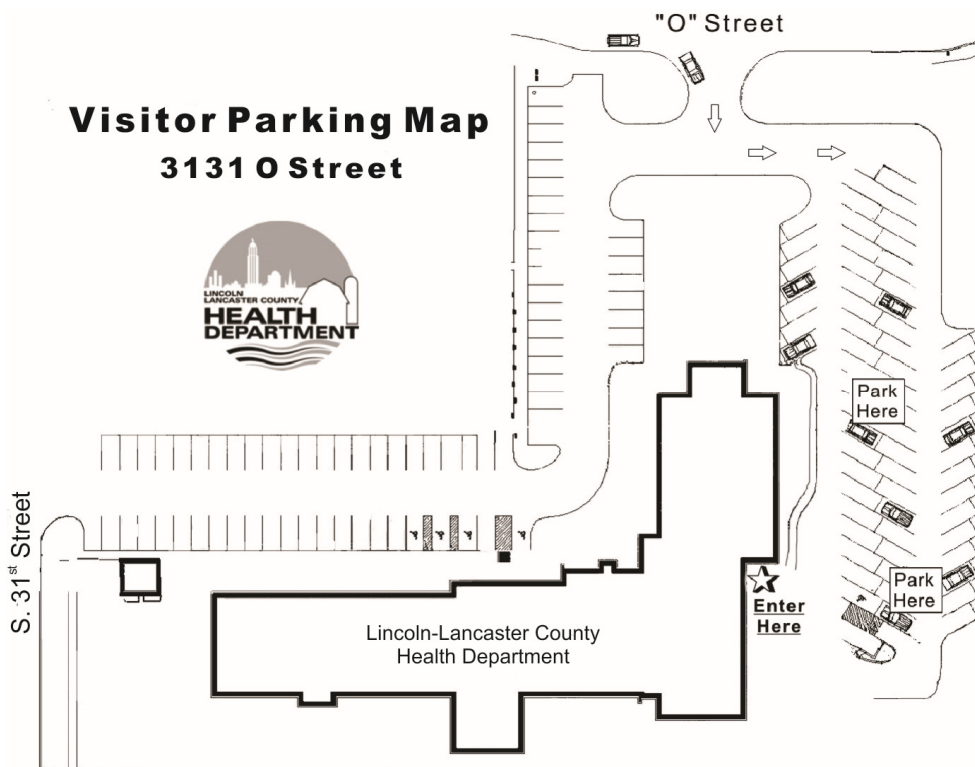
All classes are held at 3131 O Street in the lower level training center

# January-March 2019 Food Handler Class Schedule

Arrive 10-15 minutes **before** class starts to register

Accepting cash, credit cards, and debit cards

**English Prep/Cook (PC) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20**

Any person who prepares or cooks food in a food establishment must have a Prep/Cook (PC) permit. This permit is for chefs, cooks, salad prep staff, buffet line staff, deli staff, wait staff who help with cooking or stocking buffet lines or related tasks, all employees of fast food establishments, and convenience store clerks who prepare foods such as hot dogs.

The holder of a Prep/Cook permit can perform the duties of a Serve/Clean permit holder.

Class usually lasts around one and one-half hours.

**English Restricted/Shift Manager (RS) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20**

*Tests are only available in English.*

*Shift managers* are in charge of an establishment that serves time temperature control for safety food and may be the person-in-charge when the Food Protection Manager is not present; a restaurant shift manager would be an example.

*Restricted managers* work in establishments that *do not* prepare and serve time temperature control for safety food; examples would be bar managers, coffee shop managers, and bakery managers.

The holder of an RS permit can perform all the duties of a Prep/Cook *and* a Serve/Clean permit holder.

**English Serve/Clean (SC) permit good for 2 years, costs \$20**

Serve/Clean (SC) Food Handlers would include staff of establishments that do not prepare/serve time temperature control for safety foods. This permit is for bakers, bussing staff, dishwashers, wait staff and convenience store workers who do not prepare or cook time temperature control for safety foods, bartenders, hosting staff, and baristas.

*Classes are no longer scheduled for the Serve/Clean permit.* This training is available online. Alternatively, food handlers can attend a Prep/Cook (PC) class which includes the instruction required for an SC permit and costs the same. If the PC option does not meet the food handler’s needs, call (402) 441-6222 to make arrangements for one-on-one training.

## Online Food Handler and Responsible Beverage Server/Seller Training and Permits

Employees can access the online training for both food handler and beverage server/seller permits from the Food Safety web site. Go to the City home page (<http://www.lincoln.ne.gov>) and type the word “food” or “alcohol” in the search box. Click on “Search.” On the Food Safety web page, click on the “FBST” button. You can also go directly to the site by going to <https://fbstnebraska.education/> Watch the videos and read the instructions for getting started in the “Site Info” tab. Upon completion of the training, you will have earned a permit you can print any time as long as it has not expired.

Most restaurant employees should hold a Prep/Cook permit. If you are absolutely sure you will never prepare or handle food, then a Serve/Clean permit is acceptable. Within the two years the permit is valid, you can login and take additional units to receive a Prep/Cook or a Restricted/Shift Manager permit if desired or needed at no charge.

All employees who serve or sell alcoholic beverages in Lincoln must obtain a Responsible Beverage Server Training (RBST) certificate. Select the RBST training. You must complete both the RBST general training and the City of Lincoln Server/Seller (LNK) permit. Read the instructions for getting started. The LNK permit costs \$15 and is valid for three (3) years.

## Food Protection Manager (FPM) Permit: 3 years—\$30

A Food Protection Manager (FPM) permit issued by LLCHD is required for any person working as the Person In Charge of a food establishment serving time temperature control for safety foods. To get your FPM Permit, you must first pass an accredited ANSI/CFP exam: ServSafe, Prometric Inc; National Registry of Food Safety Professionals; National Restaurant Association; 360training.com, Inc.; or Above Training/StateFoodSafety.com. **Once you obtain your certification, you need to bring it to the LLCHD office, complete an application, and pay the \$30 fee.**

Prior to taking the ANSI/CFP exam, LLCHD recommends that you attend a locally available training program, study online, or study materials available through various vendors. Be sure to verify that there is a local proctored test site for the ANSI/CFP exam before paying for or taking any training program. There may be separate costs for the course and the exam.

## FPM Renewal Classes

Food Protection Manager (FPM) permits must be renewed *prior* to the expiration date by attending a Food Protection Manager Permit Renewal Class. This class will add three (3) years to the *end* of your permit’s current expiration date. Registration information is sent to FPMs whose permit is within one year of expiring.

Classes are scheduled on Mondays of odd numbered months. They alternate between mornings and afternoons.

Monday, January 28, 2019. Registration is from 7:30-8:00 am; class is from 8:00-11:30 am.

Monday, March 18, 2019. Registration is from 12:30-1:00 pm; class is from 1:00-4:30 pm.

Monday, May 20, 2019. Registration is from 7:30-8:00 am; class is from 8:00-11:30 am.

**Failure to renew an FPM permit prior to expiration will require the manager to retake the certification training and bring the new certificate to the LLCHD for a new permit.**
