



Nebraska Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program 2020

Qualifying Lancaster County residents age 60 and over are encouraged to apply for coupons that can be exchanged for eligible foods at farmers markets, roadside stands and community-supported agriculture programs. The coupons, available through the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP), are good for fruits, vegetables, honey and fresh-cut herbs. The coupons will be distributed through a random drawing based on the number of coupons available for Lancaster County.

Qualifications:

- Must be age 60 or over and meet the following income requirements:
- Gross income cannot exceed - \$23,606.00 (one-person household)
\$31,894.00 (two-person household)
- Seniors may send a proxy to register on their behalf. The proxy must bring a statement of permission from the interested senior as well as income and age documentation for the participant.
- There is a maximum benefit of \$48 per household, per season.

Coupons will be distributed to the selected recipients in early June, and they are valid through October. Participants must re-apply every year, and coupons are never guaranteed. Selected applicants will be given information on how to pick up their coupons. The SFMNP is administered by the Department of Agriculture in Nebraska. Local area agencies on aging are responsible for distributing the coupons.
