**DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY RELATED TO IMMINENT DANGER OF  
CIVIL DISTURBANCE, DISORDER, AND RIOT**

**BY VIRTUE OF THE AUTHORITY VESTED IN ME by the Charter of the City of  
Lincoln, Nebraska:**

WHEREAS, the Lincoln Municipal Code, Section 2.06.050, specifically empowers the Mayor to establish a curfew limiting the hours when people may go upon or travel the public streets and prohibit people from gathering or congregating upon the public streets, alleys, or public places or any outdoor area within the city if necessary to preserve the health, safety, and property of the residents of this community; and

WHEREAS, on this day, the extension of the curfew that was declared in the City of Lincoln on May 31, 2020 is advisable to protect the City and its residents from endangerment and harm to their health, safety, and property.

Therefore, I, Leirion Gaylor Baird, by the powers vested in me as the Mayor of the City of Lincoln and pursuant to the authority granted to me by the Lincoln Home Rule Charter and the Lincoln Municipal Code do hereby execute the following ORDER:

1. The recent acts of violence and destruction that have occurred in Lincoln constitute a local disaster and a state of emergency pursuant to the terms of City law.
2. I hereby order a City-wide curfew limiting the hours when people may go upon or travel the public streets and prohibiting people from gathering or congregating upon the public streets, sidewalks, sidewalk spaces, alleys, or public places or any outdoor area within the city as follows (collectively the "Curfew Hours") from June 1, 2020 at 9 p.m. until June 2, 2020 at 6 a.m. A person may travel upon

the public streets for the following reasons:

- a. To work or go to or from work;
  - b. To seek medical attention; or
  - c. To seek the assistance of law enforcement.
3. This Order is effective immediately and supplements, but does not replace, Executive Order 94155 and Resolution No. A-92047, affirming the Mayor's declaration of a state of emergency and authorizing the Mayor to use emergency powers pursuant to Lincoln Municipal Code 2.06.050.
4. The above Order shall remain in effect until June 2, 2020, unless renewed, extended or terminated by subsequent order. Failure to comply with this Order shall result in warnings, orders to disburse, and the imposition of penalties, fines and other remedies as provided for by law.
