

**Pedestrian Bicycle Advisory Committee**  
Minutes from February 8, 2011  
Lincoln Parks and Recreation – 2740 “A” Street

This meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. followed by recognition of the Open Meeting Act.

Approval of Minutes: Neal Thomas moved and Rick Dockhorn seconded to approve the January 11, 2011 minutes. Motion passed unanimously.

**Staff Reports**

- Bison Trail Bridge – We received notice we were approved for \$250K from RTP to help fund that project.
- Billy Wolff/Antelope Valley Trail Connector – Approval by the state to bid for construction, still waiting for approval of MOU between City and LPSNRD.
- Jamaica North Trail – No change.  
Bids for construction of the ALC will be opened this Fri. February 11, 2011.
- NRD is getting ready to initiate the work along the Billy Wolff Trail between “A” and Capital pkwy. When they start, the trail will be closed on each end for about 8 months. Trail will be 12 feet wide.
- AV Trails have been opened however they are still evaluating the situation.

**LPlan 2040 Sub Committee Report** – The committee has met every other week. A list of bullets have been put together for what folks would like incorporated into the plan. That will be sent out. Last meeting worked on trail projects and reconstruction projects. The plan has to be fiscally constrained.

Members were reminded to go on line and take the Transportation Survey for the comp plan. Because the Comp Plan has to be fiscally constrained, projects will be ranked based on the results of the survey. Maintenance and rehab projects will receive priority in this plan.

**Sub-Committee Discussions**

List of committees were provided. Comments are requested for corrections and more information. Rick D. mentioned he needs to keep his hand down more often.

Discussion on sign committee. Those that want to be on future discussions. Need a policy for what the signs look like for consistency. Use new Park and Rec. Logo. Possible Intern or Americorps person can work on this. Need to see what other communities are doing and to do more than just a paper map. Those that want to be on

the committee include Bill W., Kari R., Parks C., Dalyce, and Elaine. Need to include someone from the NRD, GPTN, Track Club on the committee. Possible apply for some tourist money. Look at having something at major trailheads etc. It is a fairly large issue that needs to be considered in the policy.

Bike To Work Committee will meet March 1, 3:00 PM in the Mayor's Office. Everyone is invited to be a part of that. Rick agreed to remain on the committee as well as Bob B. and Damon.

Had an update on Andy Clarke's visit. Friday morning he will be at the Health Dept. He will meet with the University and GPTN on Saturday with a couple of other boards. They are hoping to show him some of the trail projects. He will be at Lazlo's at 4 on Saturday and then GPTN annual meeting on Sunday.

There was a discussion of the trail connection at 10<sup>th</sup> and Arena Drive. ROW is very limited due to the RR tracks and the columns that support I-180. There is not a good connection. There has been some discussions of going underneath I-180 in the area and coming up in the area of the Champions Club but that is going to be very expensive. There was discussion of lit crosswalks to improve the crossing going east of INS and under the interstate. The area is very dark.
