

## LINCOLN PARKS & RECREATION DISCIPLINE POLICY

Our Standard Discipline Policy is as follows:

When there is an infraction of rules:

We issue warnings and encourage participants to continue playing when the behavior is corrected.

If disruptive behavior continues: after one warning

The participant is given a second warning then can resume play, if the behavior is corrected.

If disruptive behavior continues: After two warnings (refuses to listen)

The participant may be suspended for the following program day.

**A center staff person will contact parents to inform them of a suspension.**

If there is a 2nd incident of continued disruptive behavior

Our response is the same as above, a one (1) day suspension.

3<sup>rd</sup> incident of continued disruptive behavior

Same as above, but suspension for one (1) week (7 consecutive program days).

4<sup>th</sup> incident of continued disruptive behavior

Same as above, a one (1) week suspension.

5<sup>th</sup> incident of disruptive behavior

Suspension for a minimum of 30 program days.

6<sup>th</sup> incident of disruptive behavior

Suspension for a minimum of 1 year.

**PLEASE NOTE: For incidents which are more serious, we may need to move through these steps more quickly than outlined.**
