Item 8: McFarlands Pub, 710 P Street

At the HPC meeting of Sept. 20, 2012, the Commission reviewed and approved a new color scheme for the façade of 710 P Street, the original Lazlo’s location. The discussion and approval also included a conceptual design for signs for “McFarlands Irish Pub,” including a projecting sign on the brick cornice above the entrance, where Lazlo’s formerly had a sign, and a sign above the doorway. The discussion and action appeared to allow approval by staff within the designated parameters.

Because a longer period than usual has passed since that meeting and the submittal of a sign proposal this week, I want to discuss with the Commission whether you would prefer me to list the item for full review next month, or approve it based on your previous action. I will provide images at the meeting.
