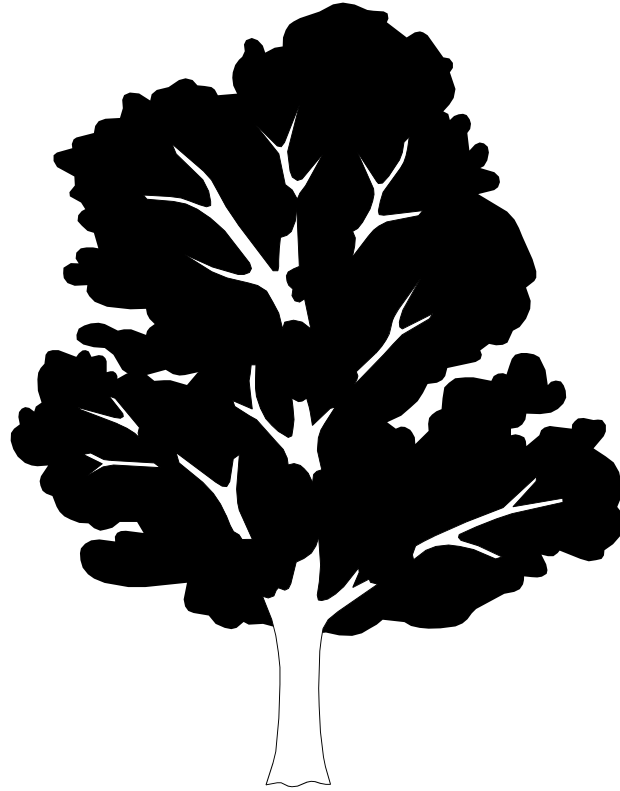


LINCOLN'S PLANT MATERIAL LIST

PLANT STANDARDS

All plant material shall be equal to or better than the requirements of the "USA Standard for Nursery Stock", latest edition, as published by the American Association of Nurserymen. All plants shall be typical of their species and variety, shall have a normal habit of growth, and shall be first quality, sound, vigorous, well-branched and with healthy, well-furnished root systems. Plants shall be free of disease, insect pests and mechanical injuries.
