



Changes to DRAFT 2040 Comprehensive Plan Update

All changes made between

July 20, 2016 and September 14, 2016

After the initial public release of the draft chapters of the 2040 Comprehensive Plan Update on July 20, 2016, some additional items were recognized for revision. All revised versions of chapters have been posted online in place of previous versions. These are all minor in nature and make corrections, better-reflect reality, or update information. Chapter 3 had two dates that needed to be updated. The “Information Technology” section of Chapter 11 was revised to better reflect trends and plans. One change in Chapter 12 corrected the TIP and CIP process from an annual process to a two year update process for CIP and an annual update process for just TIP.

All other changes in Chapters 5, 7, and 12 relate to the “annual review” process. The full annual review has not been conducted as a formal process/separate report and analysis for several years. The annual review used to involve a formal submittal process that reviewed requests from developers on new land to add to the Future Service Limit, to change growth tiers, or land use. Following slower development trends after 2006, requests from developers have been fewer, smaller, and more manageable to analyze. Therefore, the Planning Department has been allowing such requests be made at any point in the year rather than all at once during the annual review. The annual review is not required under state statutes. On an annual basis, the Planning Department produces a Benchmark Indicators Report as a way to analyze the performance of over 30 aspects of the plan.

All of these changes have been made and are reflected in the current online versions of the draft plan:

Chapter 3

- Added language about the Upper Little Salt Creek Saline Wetlands Plan that was completed in 2015. (p. 3.7)
- Changed date of final rule designating critical habitat for Salt Creek tiger beetle to 2014. (p. 3.8)

Chapter 5

- Deleted reference to “annual review” process. (p. 5.12)

Chapter 7

- Deleted reference to “annual review” process. (p. 7.12)

Chapter 11

- Completely revised section on Information Technology at the end of Chapter 11.

Chapter 12

- Deleted reference to “annual review” process. (pages 12.1, 12.8, and 12.17)
- Clarified that the TIP is prepared on an annual basis as opposed to the CIP’s two year cycle. (p. 12.12)
