

Open House Tierra Park's Water Quality Improvements

About the Project

Design work is progressing for the project, which will include removal of the failing concrete liner and addressing water quality issues. The project will realign the current channel to flow through the park, adding a new water quality feature and improving the quality of water entering Beal Slough.

Construction

Construction is expected to begin later this year. The park will remain open while construction is under way, and fencing will be used to ensure the safety of park users.

How will this affect Tierra Park?

The water quality wetlands will:

- Reduce flow velocity and erosion from more typical storm events
- Improve the water and vegetation habitat for wildlife
- Produce cleaner water for groundwater recharge

Also, one of the trails that runs through the park will be moved. Other recreational features, including the playground, won't be affected.
