

CITYWIDE ARTERIAL REHABILITATION PUBLIC PRECONSTRUCTION OPEN HOUSE TUESDAY, MARCH 26, 4:30-6:30 PM

WELCOME

Welcome to the pre-construction public open house for the Citywide Arterial Rehab Project. Construction is scheduled to begin **Mon, April 1st** and be completed by **November 3rd**.

No formal presentations are planned tonight. Representatives from the City Public Works & Utilities Dept. and the Contractor, Pavers Inc., are available to answer your questions.

SCOPE OF WORK

The City of Lincoln is planning to mill and overlay the street sections listed on the following page. The existing pavement will be milled 2" and overlaid with 2" of asphalt. Sidewalk curb ramps will also be reconstructed to meet ADA requirements at all intersections.

The segments on 17th Street, South to "A" Street, and Rosa Parks Way, Hwy 77 to S. 1st Street also include concrete base repair.

The segment on 40th Street, South to "A" Street also includes widening 1-foot on each side of the roadway.

Detours will be needed for Havelock Avenue – Touzalin to 72nd Street, 40th Street – South to "A" Street, 17th Street – South to "A" Street and for Cotner Boulevard – Fairfax to Adams Street. All other locations will be completed under traffic. The City will work with local businesses regarding access during construction. Access to local residences may be restricted at times.



ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

The Contractor shall notify all businesses and property owners a minimum of 7-days in advance of any roadway closures or changes in access. Access to local residences that front the project will be maintained for the majority of the time with the exception of pavement removal and placement and during asphalt placement. Closure of driveways will not exceed 7-days.
