Needs Assessment

The Needs Assessment addresses the volumes and types of waste being generated, existing waste management practices, anticipated future waste management needs, and adequacy of landfill/disposal capacity in Lincoln and Lancaster County.

Baseline Assessment/Survey

As part of the planning process, randomly selected residents completed a phone survey. Results will be available at the open house and are available through the online Town Hall meeting.

Evaluation of options and alternatives

The City and Advisory Committee are reviewing a wide range of components to be included in a comprehensive, integrated solid waste management system: source reduction, recycling and composting, disposal capacity, implementation considerations, and collection and handling programs. These will be summarized in a Systems Definition document and ultimately be refined for inclusion in the Solid Waste Plan. The public will have an opportunity to review the Systems Definition at a future open house.
