
The Department has reviewed the Tier 1 report submitted by Olsson Associates for the above referenced facility. This report indicates that none of the RBCA pathways failed the Tier 1 screening level. No further remedial actions will be required at this time and the investigation into the release of petroleum at your facility is now closed. However, if a problem arises in the future as a result of this release, the City of Lincoln will remain responsible for further remedial actions.

As you are probably aware, the reasonable costs associated with this work effort may be eligible for reimbursement from the Title 200 Petroleum Release Remedial Action Reimbursement Fund through the Voluntary Remedial Action provision of §66-1525(2)(d). If you so desire, you may submit an application for reimbursement from the Title 200 fund, in the proper format, to the Department. We will determine which costs are eligible for reimbursement and prepare an expense payable report for the Title 200 file for this facility. The expense payable report will detail what amount City of Lincoln will be eligible to receive once this site reaches the top of the priority list. You may request a copy of the expense payable report if you wish.

Should you choose not to submit an application for reimbursement to the Title 200 Fund at this time, please retain documentation of costs associated with remedial actions at this facility. You may apply, and be immediately eligible for reimbursement consideration once you are notified that this facility has reached the top of the priority list.
