

Appointments to the Workforce Development Board

The Mayor of Lincoln will be appointing representatives of business, education, government, economic and community development, and the workforce to serve on a new ***Greater Lincoln Workforce Development Board***. The composition of the board is mandated by the federal *Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)* which was passed into law in July of 2014 replacing the *Workforce Investment Act (WIA)*.

Responsibilities of the board include:

- Ensuring that workforce activities meet the needs of local employers and support economic growth in the region and
- Developing strategies for using technology to maximize the accessibility and effectiveness of the local system for employers and jobseekers.
