

PLUMBING JOURNEYMAN

NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants shall have at least four (4) years of practical experience in the design, layout, construction and/or installation of Plumbing equipment.

- An applicant, while employed by a person, firm or corporation regularly engaged in the installation of Plumbing equipment and registered as an apprentice, shall receive one (1) year practical experience credit for each year of full-time employment.

*The practical experience credited for applicants working for a person, firm or corporation part-time in Plumbing equipment installations shall be determined by the Board.

- An applicant graduating from a four (4) year engineering course of an accredited College or University will receive two (2) years of practical experience credit required above.
- An applicant completing a course of study, approved by the Board, in the design, construction and installation of Plumbing equipment will receive one (1) year of practical experience credit required above.
- A professional mechanical engineer registered in the State of Nebraska, will receive three (3) years of practical experience credit required above.
- The Plumbing education and training received from military service, extension courses, adult education classes, etc., may account for practical experience credit at the discretion of the board.
- Transfers: An applicant holding a valid Journeyman or Contractor/Master Plumbing License or Certificate, received by examination from another state or Municipal Governmental agency, shall be entitled to take the equivalent respective City of Lincoln Journeyman or Contractors examination without submitting any additional qualifications.
