





11th Street Corridor — Street Improvements

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Lincoln on the Move quarter-cent sales tax program is investing in street improvements to 11th Street from South to "K" streets. These improvements include a mill and overlay of the existing surface and base repairs where required.

Additional work with other funding sources includes upgrades to the existing curb ramps to comply with federal and local standards and additional priority sidewalk repairs.

PROJECT FUNDING

The total project estimated cost is \$1.5 million and will be funded using Lincoln on the Move quartercent sales tax funds and Street Improvement Vehicle Tax – Residential Rehab fund.

Lincoln on the Move funding is supporting additional street improvement projects like this across the community.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction will begin in spring 2024 and will be completed in winter 2024.





ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Construction will be completed in phased segments beginning at the south end of the project and moving north. The majority of construction will be completed with local traffic maintained. Short-term full closure to through traffic will be required during certain construction operations such as mill and overlay and concrete base repairs. Access to individual properties will be maintained.
