

# S. 14TH STREET FROM YANKEE HILL ROAD TO PINE LAKE ROAD — STREET IMPROVEMENTS

## PROJECT SUMMARY

The Lincoln on the Move quarter-cent sales tax is investing in improvements to S. 14th Street from Yankee Hill Road to Pine Lake Road. These improvements include the removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete street paving sections, concrete median, curb repair or replacement, joint and crack sealing, pavement markings and inlet top replacements. Additional work with other funding sources includes upgrades to the existing curb ramps to comply with the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements.

The Lincoln on the Move quarter-cent sales tax is a six-year program that is investing more than \$96 million into Lincoln's streets.

## PROJECT FUNDING

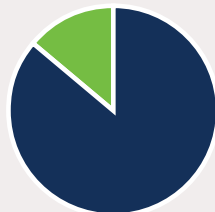
The total project cost estimate is \$1.6 million and will be funded using Lincoln on the Move quarter-cent sales tax funds and Highway Allocation Funds.

Lincoln on the Move funding is supporting additional street improvement projects like this across the community.

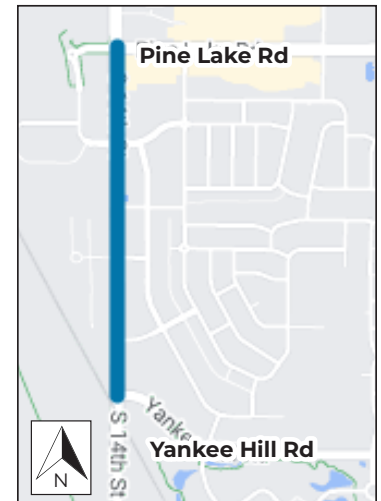


## CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction will begin in late spring 2024 and will be completed in late summer of 2024.

## ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION

- » The project will require partial lane closures and left-turn restrictions.
- » Traffic will be shifted as needed to accommodate work.
- » One lane of traffic will remain open in each direction at all times.
- » Sidewalk closures will be necessary for curb ramp reconstruction.
- » The traveling public is encouraged to find alternate routes and use the WAZE app for assistance.
