

# LEIGHTON FROM 48TH TO 70TH



# **PROJECT SUMMARY**

Lincoln on the Move (LTU) is investing in improvements to approximately 1.5 miles of Leighton Avenue from 48th to 70th streets. These improvements will include concrete pavement repair, removal and replacement of asphalt paving, concrete base repairs, curb and curb ramp replacements, inlet top replacements and the installation of a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB).

# **CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE**

This project is expected to begin construction in spring 2024 and continue until fall 2024.




#### **ACCESS DURING CONSTRUCTION**

Construction will be completed in segments to minimize the necessary closure length. Each segment will require a full closure while under active construction. Access for local residents within the construction segment will be maintained to the fullest extent possible but some restrictions will be necessary. The traveling public is encouraged to find alternative routes and to use the WAZE app for assistance.



#### **FUNDING DETAILS**

This project is programmed as a part of the commitment to voters to invest significant sales tax funds into improvement of existing streets. The total project estimate is \$2,100,000 and will be funded jointly by the quarter-cent Lincoln on the Move sales tax in accordance with ballot language and Highway Allocation Funds (aka Gas Tax).





The community is encouraged to identify any special accommodations that may be needed during construction.
