## What is a Water Service Line?

Your water service line is the pipe that connects your home to the City of Lincoln water system. The property owner owns the service line. Homes built before 1950 may have water service lines made of lead or lead-contaminated galvanized pipe. Lincoln Water System is offering to replace these old service lines at no cost to property owners.



Your home's new copper service line will be installed and comes with a two-year warranty. The cost of replacing a lead line will be paid for by the City.
