

MECHANICAL JOURNEYMAN REQUIREMENTS

NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS: Prior to an applicant being registered as a Journeyman HVAC Technician, the individual must pass the Lincoln Journeyman HVAC Technician Exam. The applicant for a Journeyman HVAC Technician Exam shall provide evidence of completing at least three (3) years practical experience as a Registered Apprentice.

- An applicant, while employed by a person, firm or corporation regularly engaged in the installation of Mechanical systems and registered as an apprentice, shall receive one (1) year practical experience credit for each year of full-time employment.
- An applicant graduating from a four (4) year engineering course of an accredited College or University will receive two (2) years of practical experience credit required above.
- An applicant completing a two (2) year course of study, approved by the Board, in the design, construction and installation of Mechanical equipment will receive one (1) year of practical experience credit required above.
- A professional mechanical engineer registered in the State of Nebraska, will receive three (3) years of practical experience credit required above.
- The Mechanical education and training received from military service, extension courses, adult education classes, etc., may account for practical experience credit at the discretion of the board.
- Transfers: An applicant holding a valid Journeyman or Contractor/Master Mechanical License or Certificate, received by examination from another state or Municipal Governmental agency, shall be entitled to take the equivalent respective City of Lincoln Journeyman or Contractors examination without submitting any additional qualifications.

Your exam application will be reviewed. If it is found that you are ineligible to take the exam you will be notified and your exam fee will be refunded.
