THE EXAM

This portion of the exam can take up to 4 1/2 hours and is in 4 parts.

- Manual J Exam
- Duct Sizing Exam
- Lincoln Gas Code Exam (1 hour time limit) This is based upon the Lincoln Gas Piping Systems Code 24.05.
- The Lincoln Adopted Amendments Exam (30 minute time limit) This is based upon L.M.C. 25.06 and 25.12

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL EXAM REQUIREMENTS

Additionally, all applicants must make arrangements with the International Code Council at ICCSafe.org to arrange to take the computer based National Standard Master Mechanical exam #W29 at an ICC approved remote test site. Do not schedule this exam until you are notified by the city that your application has been approved. Costs and scheduling of this test shall be the responsibility of the applicant. Proof of passing this exam must be submitted to the Building and Safety Mechanical section no later than the date of Lincoln's exam.
