

SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL

Hartley Elementary Survey Results

Hartley Elementary School had a total of 35 survey responses from parents/guardians. 2 of those responses were completed in Spanish. The surveys were administered both online and in-person in May of 2023.

At the moment there are no planned roadway projects in the area to coordinate implementation efforts.

35% indicated walking or rolling to/from school



57% indicated driving to/from school



71% live 1/2 mile or less from school



29% live 1/2 mile or more from school

49% said their student(s) has asked to walk or bike to/from school



20% said the safety of intersections and crossings along the walking route is discouraging



18% said the amount of traffic along the walking route is discouraging



16% said the speed of traffic along the walking route is discouraging



66% said they would let their student(s) walk or bike to/from school if issues above were addressed



Some comments made by parents and guardians include the following:

- "Crosswalk guards for kids to get across Vine Street..."
- "A crosswalk is desperately needed at 33rd and 'Y' streets. Children and families frequently try to cross there..."
- "Safety should be addressed at all times..."
- "More police to stop speeding along Vine Street"
- "...traffic is too fast on Vine & sidewalks are too close to the street. It does not feel safe to walk or stand at crosswalks"
- "No buffer between street and sidewalk. Often have to walk single file because of debris, overgrowth, or snow on sidewalk"
- "... many sidewalks are cracked and uneven along our route..."
- "Along Vine Street, too much traffic & small and narrow sidewalk"
