





- The "Zoning and Regulations" layer in the GIS Viewer shows the various zoning districts within the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County.
- There are sub-layers within "Zoning and Regulations" which fall under "Other Districts" which will be briefly explored.














In order to carry out the purposes and provisions of this title, the main uses of <u>buildings</u> and <u>premises</u> have been classified and combined into use groups based on common functional and physical characteristics ("Use Groups"). The classification of uses of buildings and premises into Use Groups provides a systematic basis for assignment of present and future use types to zoning <u>districts</u>. (Ord. 19733 §3; June 25, 2012).






In order to regulate and restrict the height, number of stories, and size of <u>buildings</u> and other <u>structures</u>, the percentage of lot that may be occupied, the location and use of buildings, structures, and land for trade, industry, residence, and size of the yards, courts, and other open spaces, the density of population, and/or other purposes, the unincorporated portions of the county are hereby divided into districts as follows:


Zoning – Other Districts

- There are various other districts within the City of Lincoln that can be seen and explored with the Development Viewer.
- Some of the commonly viewed districts include:
 - Airport zoning and noise districts
 - Historic districts and buildings
 - Capitol view corridors
 - Access Management
 - Etc.







- Capitol View Corridors are areas from various points in Lincoln and Lancaster County that the State Capitol is visible from.
- These corridors are maintained to allow the view of the Capitol to unify and enrich the community.



- The Airport Environs Noise District is the area within the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County that shows the various day-night average sound level (DNL)/noise emissions from the airport.
- Depending on a property's location within the Noise District, certain uses are not allowed.
 - In areas of high DNL, residential, healthcare and educational facilities, etc. are not permitted.



- The Airport Zoning District shows the areas within Lincoln and Lancaster County that fall within the Airport Zoning Regulations.
- These areas are subject to certain height regulations, depending on the location of a property and the height and elevation of a structure.
- This district protects the Lincoln Airport's ability to operate safely.



 Historic Districts are geographically defined areas that contain a group of buildings, sites, or structures that are significant for their historical or architectural value.
